

ROYAL SCHOOL CAVAN SCHOOL UNIFORM

ARTICLES REQUIRED BY EACH **BOY** WHEN ENTERING THE SCHOOL FROM SEPTEMBER

SCHOOL UNIFORM

- *School Pullover Grey with School Crest
- *School Tie
- *School Blazer Black with School Crest
- *Pair Grey Trousers
- Plain Shirt (Minimum of two) Grey or White
- Plain Socks (Crew Length) Black or White **ONLY**
- *School Jacket Black with School Crest
- Pair of **Black shoes** (canvas/van shoes or black trainers are not permitted)

Items marked * must be obtained from the School Uniform Supplier, Singer Sewing Centre, 41 Church Street, Cavan. Orders should be placed immediately to ensure supply for the start of the School Year. Some uniform items are also stocked by Uniformity, Cavan.

To summarise all boys must **have and wear the school blazer with or without the school pullover**. The **only** coat that can be worn is the **black school jacket**, Denims, hoodies or multi-coloured coats are not allowed and will be confiscated for a period of time, **School Jacket or No Jacket!**

Everything brought to school is to be clearly marked with the owner's full name. Care will be taken to safeguard what belongs to pupils but pupils are expected to store all their personal belongings in their locker. No responsibility can be taken for losses

SPORTS WEAR

- Pair of Navy/Black Shorts or Navy/Black Track suit bottoms
- School PE T-Shirt
- School PE Top
- Pair of Trainers (N.B. NOT black soles)

TECHNOLOGY ROOM

- White coat for practical work

SPECIAL NOTES

- Facial or body piercings are **not** allowed. No plasters can cover up facial and/or body piercings. If wearing earrings, only wear a small single stud earring in each ear.
- Pupils must present for school cleanly shaven and may be asked to leave class to shave if not so.
- Hair must have "a **natural** hair colour" and be free from shaved designs.
- Wearing of Make-up is prohibited.
- Please note that make-up, false tan, nail varnish and gel/acrylic/fake nails are deemed unsuitable in school and pose a Health and Safety risk, especially in practical subjects.
- Ties must be knotted properly and worn at an **appropriate length**.
- The tie should be worn in such a way that the top button of the shirt is **not** visible.
- Only a Plain White T-Shirt can be worn under the school shirt if desired.
- Shoes must be polished.
- Jackets, Blazers, Shirts and Jumpers must remain free from Badges other than school awarded ones.
- Ripped trousers/jumpers are **not** acceptable.
- Track suit tops/hoodies are not acceptable for wearing to and from school and may be confiscated for a period of time. Only School Blazers or School Jackets with full uniform will be acceptable at these times.
School Jacket or No Jacket!
- Runners/trainers are **NOT** acceptable footwear and must be accompanied by a doctor's certificate if worn. A note from parent/guardian is **not** sufficient.
- Pupils may wear gloves, hat or scarf with their uniform. Black, Navy and Grey are acceptable colours.

Pupils not properly uniformed may not be allowed into class and parents will be contacted.
